# Swimming Lesson Information

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Swimming starts soon (13 September to 24 September) for all students in PP – Year 6. The timetable is as follows:

Rooms 7 and 8:	9.15 - 9.55
Rooms 9 and 15:	10.00 - 10.40
Rooms 2 and 6:	10.45 - 11.25
Rooms 1 and 14:	11.55 - 12.35
Rooms PPS and 13:	12.40 – 1.20
Rooms PPB:	1.25 – 2.05

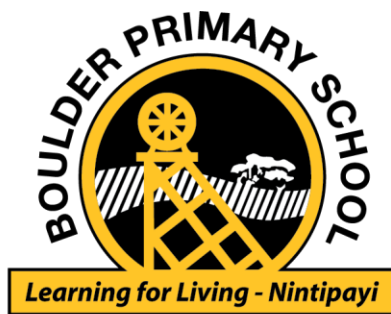
All notes and money should have gone to the office already. Students who do not pay their money or return their notes will be not be able to get on the bus to go swimming.

Children are to bring a plastic bag with a change of clothes, towel, thongs and goggles. The bag and all clothing items need to be labelled with your child's name. No school bags are to be taken to the pool. Wet bathers and towels are to be stored in the plastic bag and put in school bags when students return to school. Again, please label all belongings, especially towels.

Children must have a change of clothes and cannot remain in wet clothing for the day. All children are to change into their school clothes at the pool before they return to school. Students can only wear their thongs to and from the pool. The rest of the day they must wear their covered-in school shoes.

Children in the first lesson are to come to school with their bathers on under their school clothes ready to go. Please remember to pack underwear if your child wears bathers to school. For other lessons, students change at school before going to the pool.

All children who have ASTHMA or require an EpiPen, will require their medication on the pool deck every day. Alternatively a note from parents stating that medication is not required whilst swimming must be given to the class teacher prior to the commencement of swimming.

### **Oasis Membership**

Children with membership must provide their member number to the school prior to the commencement of swimming lessons. Please check your membership entitles your child to pool entry: some families will be receiving phone calls as their membership does not cover pool entry.

### **Oasis Café**

Children are not permitted to buy items from the Café. Parents are encouraged to also not buy items for their children. Students will have access to the school canteen for recess and lunch if they do not have a packed school lunch.

Recess and lunch times will be slightly altered for classes swimming during these times. Please contact your child's teacher if you have a question concerning recess or lunch.

### **Specialist Class Changes**

Some classes will have alternate specialist class times during swimming lessons to ensure students do not miss out on these classes.

### **Parent Volunteers**

Parents wishing to assist in individual classes are asked to contact Mr Ferguson on 9092 4100. Other parents wishing to watch their children swim, are reminded that Oasis charge a spectator fee of \$2.00 per day. Volunteers must ride the bus to and from school/Oasis with the class and assist all children to avoid the spectator fee. You must also be registered with the school before volunteering at swimming.
