While we are away, there are plans from Nature Playground to begin the redevelopment of the Early Childhood Playground. This will impact where students can enter their classroom as they will be using the car park area in front of Bottlebrush, Room 1, and Room 2 to access the area. During construction the walk-in gate on Wittenoom Street will be closed this will mean that Kindy students will only be able to enter their classroom through the small entry gate closest to their classroom and students from Bottlebrush and Sandalwood can enter their classrooms through the gate closest to Sandalwood.
