These volunteers become positive role models for our students, by forming positive relationships and exposing them to the opportunities that education can provide.

Well done to all of our students who ran in the Cross Country on Wednesday, displaying Courage – Rapa Rapa to complete the long-distance run. A special mention to Mr Harder for organising the very successful event.

NAIDOC week has been a wonderful opportunity to participate in a range of activities and to support our local Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Community. On Friday we will hold our whole school and community NAIDOC day to celebrate the history, culture and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people through a range of activities and visiting community groups.

With the school holidays just around the corner, we would like to wish a safe and enjoyable break. While we are away, there are plans from Nature Playground to begin the redevelopment of the Early Childhood Playground. This will impact where students can enter their classroom as they will be using the car park area in front of Bottlebrush, Room 1, and Room 2 to access the area. During construction the walk-in gate on Wittenoom Street will be closed this will mean that Kindy students will only be able to enter their classroom through the small entry gate closest to their classroom and students from Bottlebrush and Sandalwood can enter their classrooms through the gate closest to Sandalwood. 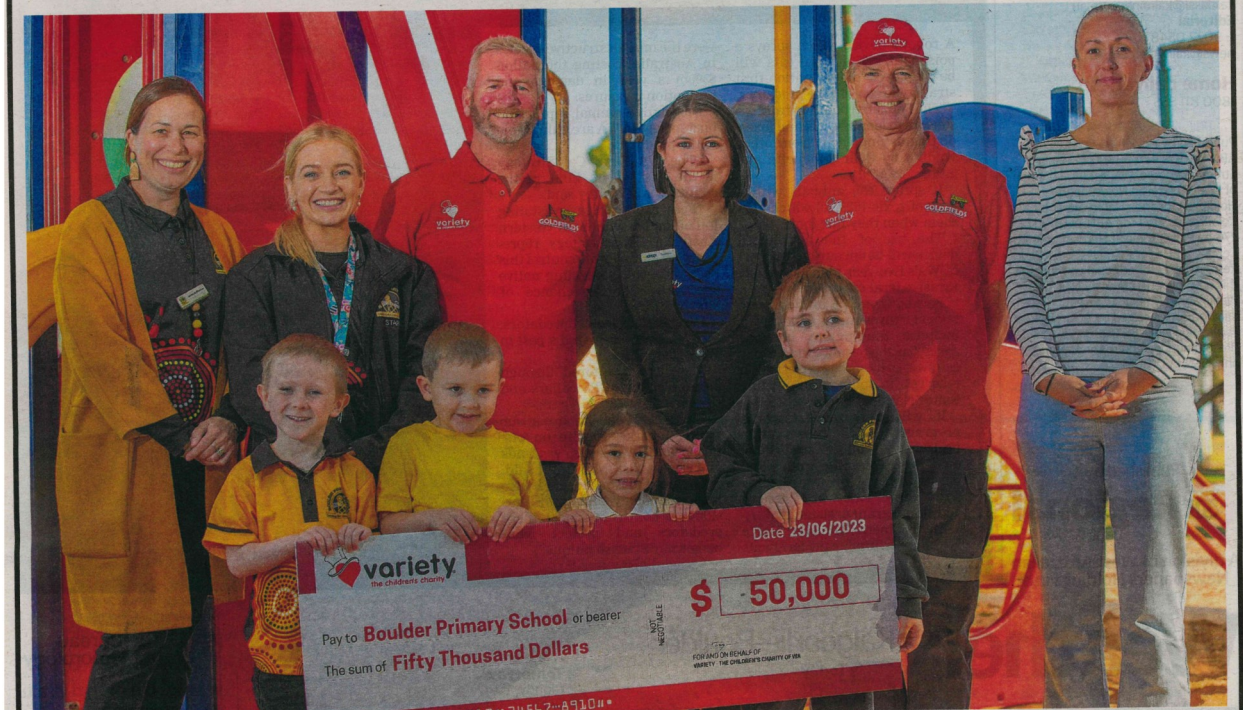

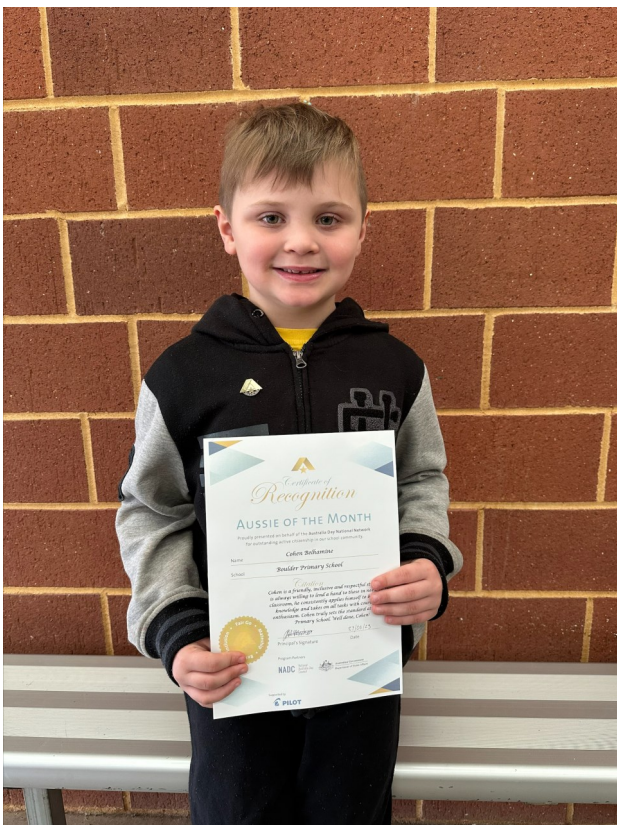

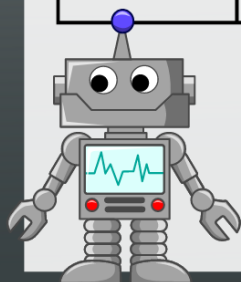
